The details below show what activities can be done at what age as a guide

## 14 yrs +

- > Start to help out on Club Night alongside teachers/coaches/administrators
- > Young Volunteer Timekeeper course
- > Aquatic Helpers Course

#### 15yrs +

- > Judge level 1 course
- Level 1 Teaching Aquatics/Water polo/Coaching Swimming (if have experience). You will not receive qualification until 16<sup>th</sup> Birthday although you can do the course.

# 16yrs +

- > Judge level 1 exam
- > Judge level 2 (once Judge 1 is passed)
- > Starter 20 hours experience post Judge Level 2
- Level 1 Teaching Aquatics/Water polo/Coaching Swimming
- > DBS Check (Safeguarding) Old CRB Check
- > Safeguarding Children Workshop (if accompanied by an 18+ yrs)
- RLSS National recognised Award Swimming Teachers & Coaches (NRASTC)
- > CPD (Continuous Professional Development) Seminars (once have Level 1 Qualification)
- Free Online CPD Introduction to Disability Swimming (once have Level 1 Qualification)
- Level 2 Teaching Aquatics/Water Polo/Coaching Swimming (once done level 1)

### 18yrs +

- > Safeguarding Children Workshop (not accompanied)
- Level 3 Coaching Swimming (once done Level 2)
